The 3-digit NAICS code categories that are indented are a subset of the 2-digit NAICS code sector directly above it. This data represents the zip codes that comprise the Bartlett area, which is larger than the corporate limits. The zip codes are: 38133, 38134, 38135, and 38029.



Bartlett has a strong **manufacturing** base that produces high value output. A **medical device manufacturing** cluster has fully developed, and that specialization is reflected in the high relative wages, and a network of related economic sectors including **machinery manufacturing and professional, technical, and scientific services**.



Construction is also a strong and growing sector in Bartlett, largely because of specialty trades. This high-skill sub-sector includes electrical and mechanical systems.



The administrative support services sector has a large presence in Bartlett that is built on the available workforce residing in a suburb of a major city.




The Memphis region has long been recognized as a global logistics and distribution center.
Bartlett plays a key role as evidenced by wholesale, transportation and courier sectors.



As in most economies, healthcare is a major sector. However, in Bartlett this sector is driven by a hospital and ambulatory medical services as opposed to long term care.

The chart to the left represents the top industry sectors comprising the Gross Regional Product (GRP) for Bartlett. Manufacturing is the largest sector, producing nearly 22% of the total GRP for the Bartlett area, compared to 11% of the United States GRP.



Bartlett outperforms both the Memphis MSA and Shelby County across Education Attainment levels, with 35.3% of residents aged 25+ holding a bachelor's degree or beyond. Another 33.3% hold an associate's degree or some post-secondary training, which helps to support the strong manufacturing base in Bartlett.

## **Shelby County Chamber Alliance**

The Alliance Cities contribute significantly to the Shelby County economy, representing approximately one-fourth of the Gross Regional Product (GRP), jobs, housing units, and local sales tax. Housing values and wages in the Alliance Cities are higher than in Shelby County.
